From the President's Desk

Dear Members,

Contrary to the expectations of some, the Club has survived and has in fact thrived during the transition period required to allow us to establish the true cash flow position of the Club. This was only made possible by the efforts of members doing whatever they could to patronize the club and a special thanks to those volunteers who have manned the clubhouse during this period.

The good news is that as we are coming to the end of the transition. We are in very good shape finically and are in final contract negotiations with James and Joan Nohoku, who we hope will take up the Club's service contract offer.

The improved financial position of the Club means that the following projects can be funded and brought forward:

- 1. 10 stainless steel pull buggies
- 2. 10 sets of hire clubs
- 3. Replacement of the final 4 golf carts to lithium, giving us a fleet of 10 two-seaters and one family cart
- 4. Acquiring a further 2, two-seater carts and one more family cart
- 5. The purchase of road base to seal and upgrade all the course cart tracks and maintain them
- 6. New tractor and implements

Some of the above are being or will be funded by grants. Thank you Greg for your grantsmanship.

The course was as good as we could get it for the Ambrose. Not bad for the middle of a very cold winter. The Ambrose was the BEST event we have ever held. Thank you, Committee members and those members who pitched in, and did whatever was required to make it a STRADDIE special. Captain Kev, well done. Not sure the members understand what goes on behind the scenes in putting this together, but my view is - no Kev no Ambrose, and that goes for all of our events.

Fair warning, just on the talk coming out of the Ambrose, we are already likely to have an oversubscribed field for next year. So, when we open the nominations in 2025, members will have 3 weeks to nominate before others. It will need to be 'first in best dressed'. Don't miss the opportunity.

As the membership continues to grow. We will have to look at introducing a member's card and other methods to ease and refine the administrative burden.
